

A special meeting of the Council of the Borough of Minersville was held at 6:00 p.m., July 23, 2010 in the Council Chambers, North Delaware Avenue and East Carbon Street.

Mr. William Angelo presided and opened the meeting with the Flag ceremony at 6:00 p.m.

ATTENDANCE:

The following Council members attended: Mr. William Angelo, President; Mr. Keith Adams, Vice-President; Mr. Albert Bobinas; Mrs. Helen Droskinis; Mr. James Kimmel; Mr. Jamie Kuehn; Mr. Paul Vuksta; Solicitor Albert Evans; and. Also attending was Police Chief Michael Combs. Mayor Joseph Post and Megan Paul, Secretary were absent.

Seven Council members were present, which constituted a quorum.

VISITORS:

Mr. Walter Miscavage, 128 Lewis Street, stated as a former Council member he would like to address some personnel issues that have been brought to his attention. He stated the sewer, street, and water employees have come forward with some serious allegations of things that have transpired in the Borough. Mr. Miscavage stated he will be attending the next public meeting to bring forth the allegations and the facts he has. Some things that will be discussed are

- Misappropriation of Liquid Fuel Funds
- Exploitation of manpower
- A review of inventory
- 23 Bonuses allegedly give from sewer separation funds on the Church Street project. Mr. Miscavage stated he is not sure if there was wrong doing with the bonuses but the finances should be looked into.
- Where workers were sent and why they were asked to do it

Mr. Miscavage feels there was minimal action taken and in his opinion the workers that have come forward are now working in a hostile environment.

The workers have approached him to take this action. He does not want to gain anything nor damage his relationship with Council because he has brought this information forward. He feels that evil triumphs when good men do nothing.

Solicitor Evans stated Council has addressed some of these issues.

An executive session was held from 6:10 p.m. to 7:59 p.m. for a personnel issue.

With no further business to discuss, Mrs. Droskinis made a motion to adjourn at 8:05 p.m.; seconded by Mr. Adams. Motion passed as presented.
