

The reorganization meeting of the Council of the Borough of Minersville was held at 7 p.m. January 6, 2020 in the Council Chambers, North Delaware Avenue and East Carbon Street.

The following Council members attended: Ms. Katie Lynn Milbrandt, Mr. Paul Vuksta, Mr. Jamie Kuehn, Mr. Ian Mahal, Mr. Robert Umbenhen and Mr. Steve Darosh. Also attending were Police Chief Michael Combs, Mr. Robert Mahalchick, Borough Manager and Magisterial District Justice David A. District Justice Platchko swore in the Borough Council members Ian Mahal, Paul Vuksta and Mike Firestine and Mayor Sean Palmer.

Mayor Palmer called the meeting to order and opened nominations of officers.

Mr. Vuksta nominated Mr. Allen Reber to the Municipal Authority; Ms. Milbrandt nominated Mrs. Jamie Zimerofsky to the Municipal Authority. A roll call vote was taken, Mr. Reber received 4 votes to serve, and Mrs. Zimerofsky received 2 votes. Mr. Reber was appointed to the Municipal Authority.

Mr. Mahal nominated Mr. Jeremy Olenick to the Sewer Authority; Mr. Olenick was appointed unanimously.

Mr. Firestine nominated Mr. Don Cuff to the UCC Appeals Board. Mr. Cuff was appointed unanimously.

Mr. Vuksta nominated Mr. Albert Evans as Solicitor; Mr. Mahal seconded the nomination.

Mr. Firestine nominated Entech Engineering as Engineering Firm; Ms. Milbrandt seconded the nomination.

Mr. Umbenhen nominated Jones and Company as Auditors for the Borough Mr. Mahal seconded the nomination.

Mr. Firestine nominated The First Bank of Minersville as the Financial Institution for the Borough; Mr. Mahal seconded the nomination.
