

## **August 23, 2017**

A general meeting of the Sewer Authority of the Borough of Minersville was held Wednesday, August 23, 2017 in Council Chambers, North Delaware Avenue and East Carbon Street. Chairman Thomas Eltringham opened the meeting with the flag ceremony at 7:00PM.

### **ATTENDANCE**

### **MINUTES**

Mr. Angelo made a motion to approve the July 2017 minutes. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.

### **VISITORS**

There were no visitors at the August meeting.

### **FINANCIAL REPORT**

The Financial report was not available for the August meeting. Mr. Mahalchick stated that the Early Intervention report would give insight into the 2018 budget. Paying the Street Department for their help was discussed. Mr. Olenick suggested prioritizing work that needs to be done, budgeting for it and paying monthly for work completed.

### **ENGINEER'S REPORT**

There was nothing new to report.

### **SEWER OPERATOR'S REPORT**

Mr. Sukeena shared a written report with Authority members. Additionally he reported that Ransom was in for generator maintenance. Mr. Sukeena reported the storm inlets by Hammer's Garage were flushed but the main was 100% blocked. After the vegetation dies off, workers will continue their work there. Flushing on Lower Delaware Avenue took longer than quoted, but now that they are good, quarterly maintenance will be done. Mr. Eltringham suggested doing the top priority lines each year. Trees on a right of way road on Teaberry Hill will be removed so the roots do not damage pipes. The chain for the grit collected has arrived and will be installed.

There was nothing new to report.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

A review of the Norwegian Township customer list will wait until after the November election.

**OLD BUSINESS**

There was no Old Business to discuss.

**CORRESPONDENCE**

Mr. Angelo made a motion to approve Tredegar to discharge a portion of their process water directly to the plant. On the question approximately 600 gallons of water a day would be coming to the plant. Mr. Olenick seconded the motion. The motion passed as presented.
